Under the terms of the August 2016 Share Placement, placement investors were entitled to free attaching options on the basis of one option for every two shares subscribed at \$0.042 per share. The market price prior to the August 2016 Share Placement was in the range of \$0.036 to \$0.040.

The funds raised in the August 2016 Share Placement were for the purpose of general working capital.
